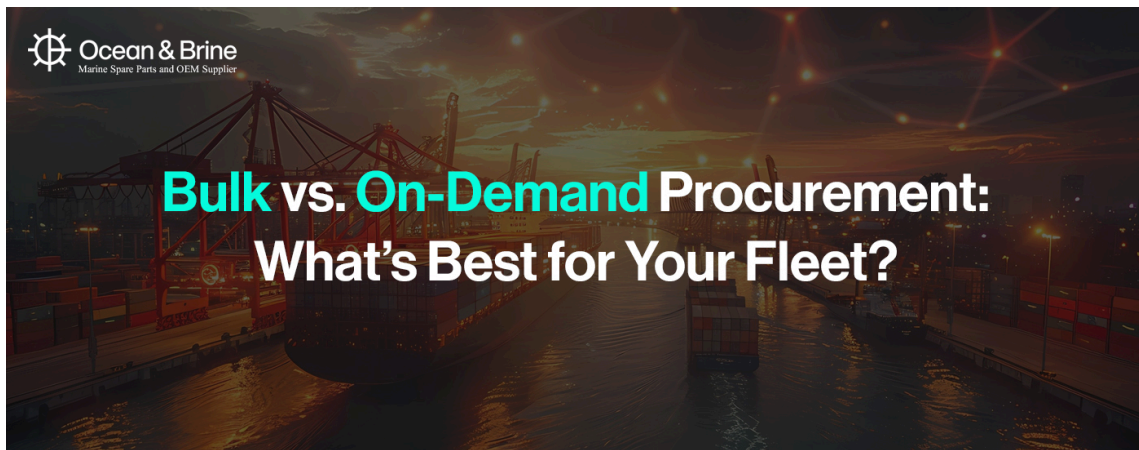
In which countries does Ocean & Brine provide services?

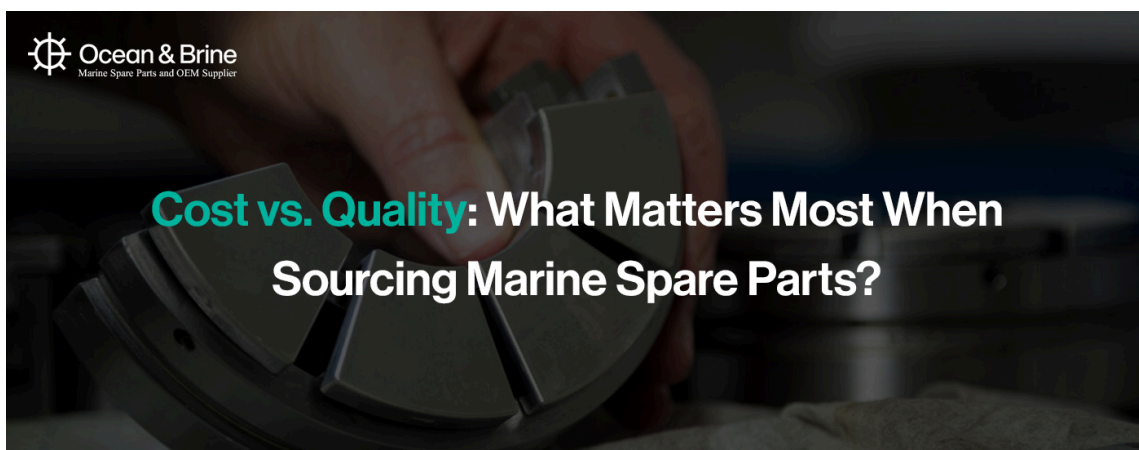
